## BURNOUT CONTEST RULES

### SEAT BELTS MUST BE USED BY ALL DRIVERS

1. Entry fee of \$10.00 per vehicle per class. \$5 for reruns (time permitting)
2. Operators must be over 21 years of age
3. Any situations that may arise and are not covered by the rules will be left to the discretion of the judges.
4. ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES WILL BE FINAL.
5. NO USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED.
6. No one will be allowed on or in the burn out contest track area except contest officials, contestants, and emergency personnel. Track is defined as an area within 25' in any direction of the contest burnout area boundaries. Anyone found in violation will result in disqualification from the contest.
7. All vehicles entered in a class must remain in the standby area until called up to the burnout area (trap).
8. All Burnouts will last for 30 (thirty) seconds, no longer, no exceptions.
9. No bleach or any other substance, other than water, will be used on the burn surface (steel plates) or tires of any entry vehicle.
10. All entry vehicles must have all beauty rings, Rally caps and any other loose items or objects removed before entering the staging or burn area. This is for everyone's safety and preinspection will be at the discretion of Burnout Officials.
11. All contestants will be placed in order of entry sign-up.
12. Anyone who does not follow the rules of this contest will be disqualified.
13. The judging of this contest will consist of three independent judges, using their knowledge of the contest, amount of smoke and crowd reaction. They will be chosen by Contest Officials.
14. Officials will notify the judges if a vehicle is in violation of any rule of the contest.
15. Harassment of any judge or official during or after the event will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of any prizes including prizes awarded.

### VEHICLE RULES

1. Cars and Trucks: Front and Rear wheel drive/
  - A. Vehicle must be in safe operating order. Vehicles must be able to pass a Safety Inspection excluding tire tread depth. All wheel weights must be removed. Any fluid leaks will be reviewed by track officials.
2. Motorcycles and Quads:
  - A. The vehicle must be in safe operating condition. Fluid leaks will be reviewed by track officials.

### GENERAL RULES:

Any Burnout instruction may be modified or changed the day of the show and will be brought to all participant's attention.

- 1.) If any entry vehicle possesses line lock, it should be engaged.
- 2.) All Burnout entries will be staged, and lined up in the standby staging area one half hour prior to the beginning of the event. **BE AT YOUR CAR!!!!!!**
- 3.) Entries will be directed to pull inside the Burnout area & place the vehicle in PARK. Cars and trucks will be chained to an anchor point. Bikes and Quads will rest their tires against a block.  
**Burnout contest will begin at 2:00 pm. Registration and line up at 1:00 pm.**
- 4.) A rope will be tied to the left upper arm of the driver. (A tug of this rope, by a Burnout official, will signify the end of the "burn" and vehicle shut down.)
- 5.) Driver will then be instructed, by a Burnout official, to place the entry vehicle in DRIVE gear.
- 6.) Driver will then be instructed, by a Burnout official, to start his "burn", by countdown from the number three (3).
7. Shifting through forward gears is allowed.
- 8.) The Burnout time limit will be 30 (thirty) seconds, beginning at the start signal, and ending at the tug of the rope, by a Burnout official.
- 9.) Driver will then be instructed to place his/her vehicle in PARK/ NEUTRAL and then remove the arm strap.
- 10.) When instructed by a Burnout official, the driver will be instructed to exit the staging and Burnout area.
